#### Description

The 'HC74 and 'HCT74 utilize silicon gate CMOS technology to achieve operating speeds equivalent to LSTTL parts. They exhibit the low power consumption of standard CMOS integrated circuits, together with the ability to drive 10 LSTTL

This flip-flop has independent DATA, SET, RESET and CLOCK inputs and Q and  $\overline{Q}$  outputs. The logic level present at the data input is transferred to the output during the positive-going transition of the clock pulse. SET and RESET are independent of the clock and are accomplished by a low level at the appropriate input.


The HCT logic family is functionally as well as pin compatible with the standard LS logic family.





FIGURE 1. HC CLOCK PULSE RISE AND FALL TIMES AND PULSE WIDTH





FIGURE 3. HC AND HCU TRANSITION TIMES AND PROPAGA-TION DELAY TIMES, COMBINATION LOGIC

FIGURE 2. HCT CLOCK PULSE RISE AND FALL TIMES AND PULSE WIDTH




FIGURE 4. HCT TRANSITION TIMES AND PROPAGATION DELAY TIMES, COMBINATION LOGIC




FIGURE 5. HC SETUP TIMES, HOLD TIMES, REMOVAL TIME, AND PROPAGATION DELAY TIMES FOR EDGE TRIGGERED SEQUENTIAL LOGIC CIRCUITS




FIGURE 6. HCT SETUP TIMES, HOLD TIMES, REMOVAL TIME, AND PROPAGATION DELAY TIMES FOR EDGE TRIGGERED SEQUENTIAL LOGIC CIRCUITS
